## FEHIM LOVIĆ

Fehim Lović se 1999. godine sa desetočlanom porodicom vratio u Zvornik. Odlučio je nastaviti porodičnu tradiciju bavljenja limarskim zanatom, te je osnovao malu radionicu u podrumu svoje obnovljene kuće. Time je osigurao redovne prihode za svoju porodicu. Predan rad mu je omogućio da postane ekonomski samostalan, te je uložio u nabavku osnovnih alata za svoju radionicu, čime je unaprijedio posao. Nakon toga, 2001. godine je registrovao radionicu za proizvodnju i montažu proizvoda od lima „Loviks”. Time je započela sa radom ova mala, ali uspješna firma, u kojoj učenici srednje škole obavljaju praksu i obučavaju se za limare tokom građevinske sezone.

Fehim Lović je uz pomoć UNHCR i njegovog partnera Hilfswerk Austria International (HWA) u 2008. godini uspio povećati proizvodne kapacitete nabavkom mašine za proizvodnju cijevi i oluka.

Tokom prodajne izložbe upriličene za Svjetski dan izbjeglica, ova firma će izlagati svoje proizvode od lima.



## FEHIM LOVIC

Fehim Lovic returned to Zvornik in 1999 with his family of ten. Lovic decided to follow the family tradition by working as a tinsmith and proceeded to set up a small metal workshop in the basement of his refurbished house that ensured a regular income for his family. His hard work made it possible for him to become self-sustainable and he invested in basic tools to consolidate his business. In 2001 he was able to register as a private tinsmith at his workshop, “Loviks”, producing and mounting metal sheet products. He has since started a small but successful company that is able to hire high school apprentices whom he trains as tinsmiths during the construction season.

Lovic acquired additional machinery in 2008 by way of a UNHCR project, implemented by Hilfswerk Austria International (HWA) and he has since expanded the production capacity of his workshop by procuring sheet-metal machinery that facilitates the production of pipes and gutters.

Mr. Lovic will exhibit his tin products at the World Refugee Day Bazaar.
