ĐURO BAJIĆ

Đuro Bajić se 2001. godine sa svojom šestočlanom porodicom vratio u selo Mokronoge u blizini Drvara. Sami su obnovili kuću od materijala dobijenog od Vlade Republike Srpske.

Đuro je samouki stolar i taj posao predstavlja jedini izvor prihoda za njegovu porodicu. Bavi se proizvodnjom prozora, vrata, vrtnog namještaja, okvira za slike, suvenira kao i drvorezbarstvom. Dugo je koristio mašinu koju je sam konstruisao. Međutim, ta mašina nije bila prikladna za izvođenje finijih radova. Kad god je bio prisiljen pozajmiti neku mašinu, morao je putovati deset kilometara do Drvara.

Kako bi prevazišao ove probleme, Đuro se putem UNHCR-a obratio Hilfswerku Austria International (HWA) tražeći pomoć. Na taj način je 2010. godine dobio kombinovanu mašinu za preradu drveta, što mu je povećalo kapacitet radionice, kao i kvalitet proizvoda. Đuro će u toku prodajne izložbe upriličene za Svjetski dan izbjeglica izlagati suvenire od drveta, vrtni pribor i okvire za slike.



DJURO BAJIC

Mr. Bajic and his family of six returned to Mokronoge, a village near Drvar, in 2001. With construction materials donated by the RS Government the family reconstructed their house by themselves.

Djuro is a self-taught carpenter and his work provides the family with their only source of income. He produces windows, doors, garden furniture, picture frames, souvenirs and carvings. In the past he worked on a rough self-built woodworking machine made of timber. This improvised machine was not suitable for the fine and detailed work which Djuro wanted to create and in the past he needed to travel 10 km to Drvar to use other people's machinery.

The situation was not ideal so Djuro approached Hilfswerk Austria International (HWA) through UNHCR to request assistance. In 2010 UNHCR was able to provide Djuro with a combined mechanised woodworking machine which has allowed him to improve the capacity of his workshop and the quality of his products. At the WRD Bazaar you can find Djuro's timber souvenirs, garden accessories and picture frames.
