Hilfswerk BiH

Hilfswerk International's (HWI) Bosnia and Herzegovina mission, founded in 1996, is their first international effort. Since then, HWI has provided continuous aid in housing, livelihoods, social services, and more for refugees, minorities, and those in need. Their success in BiH has served as a model for other HWI missions worldwide.

Since the beginning of its engagement in BiH, HWI has diversified activities in the country towards poverty reduction, socio-economic development, strengthening civil society role in human rights promotions, and support to the most vulnerable groups in reconciliation, reintegration, and social integration, thus contributing to the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) fulfilment.

HWI in Ukraine

- reached 1,700 refugees
- supported more than 58,000 people
- provided medical care for 80,000 children
- supported 8 orphanages with food, clothing and medical care
- psychosocial care for 1,173 people
- 3,000 families received winter care kits
- built more than 50 power generators

HWI in Moldova

- the support of 15 refugee shelters
- providing urgently needed equipment such as mattresses and blankets
- the distribution of food and hygiene articles
- psychosocial support

HWI in South Caucasus

- 80 local representatives of associations
- 100 active citizens
- 120 representatives of the administration (e.g. education, social or youth departments)
- 40 regional government representatives
- Members of the 15 – 20.000 socially disadvantaged households in the target communities

- Hilfswerk International has been helping the people of Bosnia and Herzegovina since 1996. However, the difficulties in the Western Balkans go beyond the country's borders. That is why we also accompany people in Serbia, North Macedonia and Montenegro on their way to a better future.

We achieve this by: promoting young entrepreneurship, strengthening the institutional entrepreneurial ecosystem and preventing conflicts through sport-programs for disadvantaged children.

HWI in Zimbabwe

- Hilfswerk International has been assisting the people of Zimbabwe since 2010. Together with the local population, our goal is to improve agricultural resilience to climate change and the food situation in the country. We at Hilfswerk International work closely with farmers in our project regions of Lupane, Matobo and Insiza. We focus on the cultivation and marketing of drought-resistant crops such as amaranth and quinoa.

HWI in Colombia

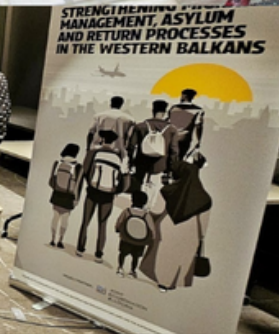
- Our decades of experience in Colombia have taught us one thing: protecting the Amazon rainforest can only be achieved through cooperation with its inhabitants. We are convinced that education is also an important key to success. That is why in 2022, in our project region Guaviare we focused on implementing an educational concept for rainforest protection in schools.

HWI in Afghanistan

- We distributed a total of 423 food packages, 366 blankets and 4,758 square metres of floor insulation. With this we reached: 141 vulnerable households with food parcels and another 122 households with winter packages containing warm clothes, thermofurms, blankets and floor insulation material.

HWI in Central Asia

Young people in Central Asia face a high risk of poverty and unemployment. They need prospects. Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan and Tajikistan have to promote regional development accordingly. Hilfswerk International supports the region in this project with an innovative, sustainable and comprehensive programme. In this way, we accompany the youth in Central Asia into a stable future.
